

2021 Graduation and Employment Rates

Prospective students often ask how graduates from our programs are doing to help make a well-informed decision about applying at AIAM.

The following is according to our 2021 Accrediting Commission of Career Schools and Colleges (ACCSC) Annual Report Graduation and Employment Charts submitted October 2021. The reporting period runs from July 1 through June 30 of each year and is determined by taking the programs normal length of completion in months multiplied by 150 percent and adding three (3) months for employment.
